National Students: Admission of Azerbaijani citizens is centrally managed by the State Examination Center (SEC) of the Republic of Azerbaijan. This standardized process ensures impartiality and merit-based selection for all national applicants.





International Students: The admission of international students is conducted by the University Admission Commission, following clear and fair criteria. The process is designed to evaluate all applicants equitably, without discrimination based on nationality, race, religion, gender, or any other status.
