

campus. LED lights significantly consume energy than less traditional bulbs and have a much longer lifespan, making them both an environmentally friendly and costeffective choice.






- Open windows and natural ventilation are prioritized to reduce the need for artificial cooling during warmer months.
- Skylights and well-placed windows allow for ample daylight, minimizing the dependence on artificial lighting during the day.






These features help us reduce electricity usage related to lighting, heating, and cooling, and contribute to a more sustainable and comfortable learning environment.
